For new member applications, there is a \$5 application fee. Add \$5 to the dues cost of the membership level you choose. For instance, if you apply at the Loomis Level, your check should be \$80 (\$75 plus \$5.) Make the check out to "California Pioneers of Santa Clara County." Mail your completed application form and check to California Pioneers of Santa Clara County, Membership Chair, P.O. Box 8208, San Jose, CA 95155-8208.

All membership applications will be reviewed at the next monthly Board Meeting of the California Pioneers of Santa Clara County. You will be notified of the Board's decision immediately following the Board Meeting.

## **Renewing Your Dues**

The California Pioneers of Santa Clara County dues are owed on January 1<sup>st</sup> of each year, unless the member is a Lifetime Member. Your membership expiration date will be printed right after your name on the mailing label of your Trailblazer journal that you will get in the mail. Renewal reminders will be mailed out in December. If you enclose a self-addressed, stamped envelope with your dues, your membership card will be mailed back to you; otherwise you may pick your card up at the next luncheon.

## **General Information**

The California Pioneers of Santa Clara County was established in 1875. It is one of the two oldest pioneer societies in California. The California Pioneers of Santa Clara County was formed with about 400 members. We are proud to state today, after about 140 years, we still have more than 400 members.

Your dues and contributions go toward our mission, which is to promote, preserve, and celebrate the history of Santa Clara County and the heritage of its past generations. We collect, archive, and educate; and encourage research and scholarship.

Some of our many projects that further our mission, and for which you may volunteer, include:

- Maintaining our first class Paulson House Museum at History San Jose (where our exhibits are displayed each Sunday and on special days; and where he hold our Board Meetings).
- Conducting docent-led tours of the Paulson House Museum.
- Preserving our artifacts, ephemera, photographs, film, art, and furnishings.
- Protecting and caring for our historic Hacienda Cemetery (which is on the National Register of Historic Landmarks).

- Utilizing modern technology for educational outreach, including our renowned Pioneers Film Archive, our History Calendar Santa Clara County, and the internet.
- Publishing the quarterly journal, Trailblazer, with historical articles and news of interest.
- Conducting our annual Essay Contest, which has been adding scholarly research and school-age essays to our community since the 1950s.
- Organizing our quarterly luncheons with entertainment and speakers.
